MOTION #2:

It was moved by Dodson and seconded by Griffin to expel eighth grade student #15-16-01 from Centralia City Schools for the remainder of the 2015-2016 school year through February 28, 2018 of the 2017-2018 school year for gross disobedience and misconduct for bringing a knife to school and threatening other students with bodily harm on March 17, 2016, which is a violation of school rules. Motion carried.

President Johnson verbally expressed appreciation to Dan Griffin for serving as hearing officer and providing necessary information to help us consider the following five factors.

1. The egregiousness of the student's conduct;
2. the history or record of the student's past conduct;
3. the likelihood that such conduct will affect the delivery of educational services to other children;
4. the severity of the punishment; and
5. the interest of the child.
